- Investing in Water Infrastructure: Supporting irrigation expansion and water storage projects to enhance drought resilience and productivity in southern Alberta.
- Enhancing Trade and Market Access: Strengthening Canada's position in global markets through trade policies, promotion of Canadian products, while reducing trade barriers.
- Supporting Innovation and Sustainability: Encouraging adoption of precision agriculture, regenerative practices, and clean technologies through targeted funding and regulatory modernization.

We would welcome the opportunity to meet with you to discuss these priorities in more detail and explore how Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada can support the long-term competitiveness and sustainability of our region's agricultural sector.
